

## **Nadadores at Junior Olympics**

Laredo Nadadores successfully competed at the Junior Olympics Swim Meet held at San Antonio Natatorium in San Antonio Texas. Over 450 swimmers from eight teams participated in the meet. Nadadores fielded 8 swimmers at the competition. This meet is for swimmers who do not have qualifying times for the regional championship meets. The team placed 5th overall with 165.5 points. Nadadores posted the highest Points per Swimmer average (20.68 points) than any other team in the competition.

Tony Dunivant (age 12) was the top performer with 51.5 points. He came 1<sup>st</sup> in 200 Back and 400 IM, 2<sup>nd</sup> in 50 Fly, 50 Breaststroke and 100 Back, 3<sup>rd</sup> in 50 Back. He made STAGS qualifying times in 3 events. Mathew Cavazos (12) scored 40 points, with 2<sup>nd</sup> in 400 IM, 3<sup>rd</sup> in 100 Back and 100 Free. Carlos Galvan (13) scored 23 points, with 1<sup>st</sup> in 400 IM, 2<sup>nd</sup> in 500 Free. Joan Nava (12) scored 19 points with 4<sup>th</sup> in 100 Breast and 200 Breast. Pedro Palacios (9) scored 25 points, with 2<sup>nd</sup> in 200 Free and 3<sup>rd</sup> in 50 Back. Diego Galvan (9) scored 8 points and came 5<sup>th</sup> in 100 Back. Fausto Sotelo (8) scored 2 points with 7<sup>th</sup> in 100 Free. Abdu Benruwin (9) had his best showing in 50 Breast where he came 11<sup>th</sup>.
