



Laredo Nadadores Shine at the Swim Meet

Laredo Nadadores successfully competed at the Short Course Junior Olympics (South) competition held at Corpus Christi Natatorium in Corpus Christi. The team entered nine swimmers who swam 64 swims and scored 290 points. Nadadores posted the highest Points per Swim average (4.53 points/swim) than any other team in the competition. Which means on average every swim was in the top five of every event. Every swimmer the Nadadores fielded in the competition earned a medal by placing in the top three of an event.

Aneesa Mohammed (age: 9) was the top girls performer with 62 points. She placed first in 100 yard Breast Stroke and 200 yard Individual Medley. Second in 100 yard Individual Medley, 200 yard Freestyle, and 100 yard freestyle. Third in 50 yard Breast Stroke. Fourth in 50 yard Freestyle and 50 Yard Butterfly. Aneesa achieved two STAGS times in this meet.

Paola Sotelo (age: 10) was second top scorer with 60 points. She placed first in 100 yard Butterfly, 100 yard Freestyle, and 200 yard Individual Medley. Third in 50 yard Backstroke, 100 yard Individual medley, 50 yard Butterfly, and 100 yard Backstroke. Fourth in 100 yard Breaststroke. Fifth in 50 yard Breaststroke. She achieved three STAGS times in this meet.

Joann Nava (age: 11) was the third best girls swimmer with 18 points. She placed second in 200 yard Breaststroke, third in 100 yard breaststroke, sixth in 50 yard Breaststroke, seventh in 200 yard Individual Medley.

Ayeesha Mohammed (age: 11) was eligible to swim in only two events and she placed first in both 200 yard Backstroke and 400 yard Individual Medley. She earned 18 points for the team and achieved STAGS times in both events.

Mathew Cavazos (age: 11) was the top performer among boys with 47 points. He placed first in 50 yard Freestyle, second in 100 yard Freestyle, 50 yard Butterfly, and 50 yard Breaststroke. Third in 50 yard Backstroke and 100 yard individual Medley. Fourth in 200 yard Freestyle. He achieved STAGS times in 50 yard Freestyle.

Danny Rodriguez (age: 11) scored 30 points and was the next best boys swimmer. He placed second in 100 yard Breaststroke, third in 100 yard Butterfly, fifth in 100 yard Freestyle, and fifth in 50 yard Breaststroke. Sixth in 50 yard Backstroke and 100 yard Backstroke.

Diego Galvan (age: 9) tied for the second boys top performer with 30 points. He placed third in 100 yard Backstroke and 50 yard Breaststroke. Fifth in 50 yard Backstroke, 50 yard Butterfly, and 200 yard Freestyle. Sixth in 50 yard Freestyle and 100 yard Freestyle.

Tony Dunivant (age: 11) scored 17 points. He placed second in 200 yard backstroke, third in 100 yard Breaststroke, and fifth in 100 yard individual medley.

Carlos Galvan (age: 12) earned 14 points. He placed third in 50 yard Breaststroke, sixth in 100 yard Butterfly, seventh in 200 yard Freestyle and 50 yard Butterfly.

The Nadadores will be represented by Ayeesha Mohammed at the Texas Age Group Championships (TAGS) to be held in Dallas this month on March 12-15. She will be swimming in five events at this meet. This will be the last meet of the season for Laredo Nadadores. Our next season (Long Course Meters) will start in April. Tryouts to join the team will be held from April 1st.
